- Preservation of wooden structures, specifically as a fence preserver
- New Zealand manufactured
- Bituminous / emulsion polymer product
- High degree of water repellence
- Retard distortion, movement and splitting of timber
- Non-Flammable
- Non-corrosive to metals
- Application by brushing or dipping, can be sprayed
- Apply to dry timber
- Stir prior to use
- Don't thin or dilute
- Timber requires one coat only
- One litre will cover approximately 3 to 4 linear meters of post and rail (3 rails) fence
- One litre will cover approximately 2 to 3 square meters
- The timber will require a recoat after 3 to 5 years
- Storage life of 12 months
- Some sediment might form at the bottom of the container which will dissolve when stirred
- Not to be used as a marine anti-fouling paint
- Not to be used as a pruning paint on trees or shrubs
- Not to be used in the commercial treatment of timber
- Wear eye/face protection as splashes are likely during use
- Excess on skin may be removed with olive oil
- Wash the affected area with soap and water
- Avoid inhaling vapours
- May be harmful if swallowed
- Can cause serious eye damage
- Call Poisons Centre 0800 764 766 or local doctor if patient feels unwell
- Launder contaminated clothing before re-use
- Stains can be removed with kerosene or diesel
- Avoid contaminating streams and natural waterways
- If container is not to be recycled, crush or puncture before disposing to approved landfill or hazardous waste facility
